Once a silent auction round has been announced as closed, those persons remaining in the designated area will be allowed to stay and continue bidding on their items of interest until the bid sheets are collected. The highest bidder, meeting the minimum bid increment, will be the winner of the item. The winning names will be posted on the Silent Auction winner board. To collect the item(s) you have won, go to the cashier's table and make the required payment. Bring your receipt back to the Silent Auction section to receive the item(s) that you have won.
